Kernan Fencing – It was discussed that since Kernan Road has been slightly graded for drainage in one area the fences appear to be only 4'. This now allows people who are travelling by car or walking along the sidewalk to see right over the fence and into several homeowners yards. Two homeowners have asked for a special variance to allow them to put up an 8' fence. The Board will approve their requests with conditions.

Private Property Pond Signs – The Association will purchase 20 "Private Property, No Parking, No Fishing, No Dogs" signs and posts. Homeowners along ponds will have the opportunity to purchase them from the Association at our cost. By purchasing in bulk it will not only save money per sign, but also ensure neighborhood uniformity. **David made a motion to purchase the signs and posts. Helen seconded. All in favor.**

New Landscape Company – Given the numerous issues and concerns we've had with the quality of landscaping, the Association will solicit new bids for landscape.

Amendments – We will begin putting together a few amendments that either need to be included in our CCRs or modified. We will plan to do another mail out later this year. We have volunteers willing to walk around and speak with their neighbors to ensure we hear from all homeowners and get their voices heard.

Lighting and Plumbing at Entrances – We will be getting bids for new landscape lighting and plumbing at the Kernan entrances once construction is complete. We will also look into landscape lighting in the tree island at the MLB entrance and replacing the old flood lights with new LED lights. This will save us money on the electricity bill. We also need a new locking electric box behind the MLB entrance sign.
